

DR WILLIAM CHOI



Dr. William Ka Lun Choi was born and educated in Hong Kong. He graduated from the College of Dentistry, University of the East, Quezon City in 1981. He spent 2 years in the Bataan Refugee Processing Center as a project coordinator for refugee relief. Then, he went to Taipei, Taiwan, took and passed the national dental board. Dr. Choi was recruited as a resident dentist in the Dental Department, Mackay Memorial Hospital, Taipei. He had comprehensive resident training in hospital dentistry and received intensive training in the Occlusion and TMJ Clinic in the National Taiwan University. Dr. Choi was promoted as the chief resident, visiting staff and then department chairmen of the Department of Dentistry, Mackay Memorial Hospital, Taipei majoring in Occlusion, TMJ and Oro-facial pain, and Oral rehabilitation.

Dr. Choi went to pursue his further study in the Orthodontic Department, St. Louis University Missouri, U.S.A. and graduated with a Master Degree in 1993. Then he went back to Taipei and started his private practice specializing in Orthodontics, Dentofacial Orthopedics & TMJ therapy until now. He was honored as a diplomat of the American Board of Orthodontics in 2003 and was the Board of Examiners, Taiwan Board of Orthodontics.

Dr. Choi was very active in community services in the Rotary club of Taipei, Taiwan. He served as the President from 2004 to 2005. He was also the founding member and past president of the Chinese Dental Services aiming in serving the orphans and underprivileged.
